Black Krim- 70 days, HL, I, 12 oz, mahogany, rich spicy taste

Black Prince- 70 days, HL, I, Siberian, 8 oz., some spice, rich

Brandywine- 85 days, HL, I, Amish, huge, best in greenhouse

Carmello- 70 days, HL, D, delicious 8 oz. French fresh mkt. variety

Caspian Pink- 75 days, HL, I, Russian "brandywine", delicious

Celebrity- 70 days, D, 8 oz. fruits, reliable and good tasting

Cherokee Purple- 75 days, HL, I, rich, large, pink-purple

Cosmo Volkov- 65 days, HL, I, large early Russian red, tasty

Dona- 65 days, HL, I, 4-6 oz., French mkt. variety, tasty

Early Girl- 60 days, I, 4-6 oz., reliable and popular

Golden Girl- 70 days, D, 8 oz. gold, sweet, dense, creamy

Green Zebra- 70 days, HL, I, 4 oz., green with stripes, zippy

Legend- 65 days, large delicious red for NW. From OSU. Blight resistant

Magnus- 70 days, HL, I, 6 Oz., dark pink from the Livingston Collection

Margo- 70 days, D, disease resistant, French fresh mkt., 6 oz. red

Marmara- 75 days, I, similar to Marmande but more prolific, French fresh mkt., 5 oz. red

Moskvich- 60 days, HL, I, 4-6 oz. Siberian red, rich

Momotaro- 70 days, I, favorite tomato from Japan, pink

Old German- 75 days, HL, I, large Amish with yellow and pink streaked fruits, rich taste, beautiful

Oregon Spring- 60 days, D, large early red for cool springs

Rose de Berne- 75 days, HL, I, 8

oz. juicy Swiss pink fruits

Royesta- 70 days, I, 6-8 Oz. red European fresh mkt. variety

Siletz- 60 days, D, large early slicer for PNW

Super Fantastic- 70 days, I, well-balanced flavor, large, red

Taxi- 65 days, D, 4 oz. yellow, low acid and early

Salad/Sauce

Amish Paste- 80 days, HL,I, large, dense, sweet for sauce, wispy foliage

Black Plum- 70 days, HL, I, Russian, sauce, dry, or fresh

Bloody Butcher- 55 days, HL, I, early small 4 oz., good tasting fruit to start things off...

Flamme- 70 days, HL, I, orange, French, sweet and fruity, beautiful

Japanese Black Trifele- 80 days, HL, I, pear-shaped, meaty for sauce, good for canning

Juliet - 60 days, I, 2" red oval fruits, prolific, for salad, sauce, or drying

Lime Green Salad- 60 days, D, 3 oz. chartreuse fruit, delicious

Matina- 60 days, HL,I, rich tasty red, German, 2-4 oz. fruits

Milano- 60 days, I, San Marzano type but much earlier!

Patio- 70 days, D, thick rugose foliage, 2 ft. plants for pots

San Marzano- 80 days, HL, I, traditional meaty sauce tomato

Stupice- 60 days, HL,I, early Czech variety for salads

Tigerella- 60 days, HL, I, red with stripes, juicy, cute

Viva Italia- 75 days, D, 3" sweet roma, disease resistant

Cherry Tomatoes

Black Cherry- 65 days, I, complex,rich black tomato taste in a cherry

Cherry Baby- 70 days, I, good tasting red currant sized fruits

Egg Yolk- 75 days, HL, I, green blushing yellow when ripe, sweet and fruity

Gardener's Delight- English heirloom, large cherry, good tomato taste...not just sugar

Gold Nuggets- 60 days, HL, D, low-acid yellow cherry, NW variety

Grape- 60 days, I, red grape oval tomatoes kids love

Green Grape- 70 days, D, delicious chartreuse ovals

Matt's Wild Cherry- 60 days, HL, I, wild plant with small, very sweet intense fruit

Rosalita- 60 days, I, rosy pink grape tomato, cute

Sun Gold- 60 days, I, bright orange fruits, an island favorite

Sun Sugar- 60 days, I, much like Sun Gold but crack resistant

Sweet Chelsea- 65 days, HL, I, jumbo, sweet red cherry, fruits in clusters

Sweet Million- 65 days, I, red prolific, sweet, crack resistant

Tumbling Tom Red- 70 days, D, cascading plant for baskets or pots, sweet red fruit

Yellow Jelly Bean- 70 days, I, yellow grape tomato, cute

Yellow Pear- 70 days, HL, D, cute, pear-shaped fruit
